Note

- Counselors do not have to pay unless they are actually in the water with the campers.
- Camps are not to arrive until 12:30PM.
- All campers must participate in a swim test and must wear a wristband. The pool desk will provide wristbands and it is the camps responsibility to assign the proper wristbands to the campers each day.
- A pool orientation and rule review will be given to all campers on the first day (if a new group/session comes in, indicate so and a new orientation & swim test will be done.
- Campers are not to use the lawn chairs and must set up in the grass area.
- If using a billing option, the Lemont Park District will keep track of the number of campers each day and the camp must also keep track in order to confirm numbers.
- All camps must check in at the pool window before entering the pool area.
- There is no fee for not showing up on a date that you scheduled to.

Lemont Park District Daily Camp Visit Rules

1. Weather: The aquatic supervisor or manager on duty has the right to cancel a party at any time due to weather. If weather is in question we will make every effort to contact you at the phone number(s) provided.
2. For any reason the pool has to be closed due to an individual in your group getting ill in the pool there will be NO refund granted and the pool must shut down immediately. .
3. Any persons known or suspected of having communicable disease shall not use the pool.
4. Running, Boisterous or Rough play is prohibited.
5. Spitting or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
6. Lifeguards have the authority to enforce all pool rules. Patrons who repeatedly violate the rules may be asked to leave the pool.
7. No alcohol is permitted inside or outside the pool area. Persons who seem intoxicated deemed by the manager will be immediately ejected from the facility.
8. Management reserves the right to implement new pool rules without notification.

All Facilities of the Lemont Park District are Tobacco/Smoking Free environments. All fees are due upon reserving the facility. No alcohol is permitted on the premise inside or outside of any park district facility without the consent. Persons using the park district facilities will be charged for damage done to park district property and equipment. All renters reserving facility space must provide adequate supervision (in addition to lifeguards). Additional charges occur due to repairs, clean-up and service requested above and beyond the initial rental fee.
